

## Asbestos Management Policy

The ARA Electrical Group have an obligation to ensure the health, safety, and welfare of all workers and others at their place and work. This includes ensuring safe work procedures are in place and that only people who are competent and suitably trained (and licensed where appropriate) undertake their respective work activities.

ARA Electrical has an obligation under the Work Health and Safety Act and Regulation, as well the SafeWork NSW Code of Practice, How to Manage and Control Asbestos in the Workplace to provide a safe work environment, systems and procedures to ensure the management of Asbestos.

Managing the risks associated with asbestos involves:

- Identifying asbestos and ACM at the workplace and recording this in the asbestos register
- Assessing the risk of exposure to airborne asbestos
- Eliminating or minimising the risks by implementing control measures as per Safe Operating Procedures
- Reviewing control measures to ensure they are effective.

This policy must be adhered to by all workers to ensure their safety in the workplace. Any breach in adhering to this policy may result in disciplinary action.
